President's Report

- New membership forms now available
- Report on state seminar programs:
 - Victorian seminar on Women in Sentencing: run in conjunction with Office of Corrections. ANZSOC members offered a discounted registration fee.
 - Chris Cunneen ran one on juvenile justice as part of Institute's Seminar series; again, ANZSOC members given discounted registration. Next one planned on Deaths in Custody.
 - Rod Broadhurst to run seminar in WA in July.

Treasurer's Report

- Report tabled. Ensuing discussion covered the following points:
- Membership numbers: still down. List of non-renewed members distributed to State Reps for them to contact. List of current members also distributed.
 - Butterworths: Difficulties in identifying/clarifying with Butterworths who is actually receiving Journal.
 - Finances:
 - Two separate accounts - one for in-coming membership monies; this used to pay Butterworths. The other is for conference monies.
 - Need to clarify how many student subscriptions because they are being subsidised.
 - Motion: that Society provide discount to unemployed at student rate. Moved - Christine Alder. Seconded - Ian O'Connor. Passed.
 - Membership drive:
 - Suggested by John Braithwaite that a student be employed to draw up list of staff at universities, police academies and other institutions involved in criminal justice/policing studies. Write to these people with offer that if they join Society now, this will cover next year's subscription, as well as ensure free copies of this year's journal issues. Send out conference flier with each letter.
 - Send out letter with same offer to those persons who attended the Melbourne family conference workshop and to presenters at this year's Criminology Conference who are not yet members.
 - Auditing: Conference accounts still being tidied up.

Secretary's Report

Editor's Report

Report tabled.

- Exchange of articles: discussion of possibility of exchange of one article per year between the ANZJ of Crim and the German Alternative Criminology Journal. Editorial Board of ANZJ of Crim would be responsible for selection of most suitable article from our journal. Problem: how to get their articles translated into English; may have to pay for translation, which would be expensive.
Action: obtain quote of translation costs for discussion at next meeting.
- Conference; not generating enough papers for Journal. Presenters need more encouragement.

Conference Report


