1 Journal Editorship

Arie formally moved that "The executive appoint John Pratt as editor of the ANZSOC Journal for a period of three years, and accept the nomination of Reece Walters as book review editor, also for a period of three years".

Seconded Russell Smith **Carried!**

Arie formally moved that the Society's Editor be included as a member of the Executive ex-officio.

Seconded Kate Warner. **Carried!**

2. Society Web Page.

Arie has volunteered to prepare a web page on behalf of the society.

3. Conferences 1999 and 2000

It was pointed out that Tasmania, the Northern Territory and South Australia have not so far hosted a conference.

Kate Warner offered to host the 1999 conference in Tasmania. Alternately, Arie might host the 1999 conference in Victoria with Kate hosting the conference in Tasmania in February 2001. There was some discussion about moving the conference date permanently to February, but no resolution of this issue. The Executive will revisit the issue of future conferences in later teleconferences.

4. Web Ring

Mark Israel suggested that the society try to erect a web ring whereby different institutions take responsibility for searching different areas of interest and specialisation. This would all form a single main resource with links to other sites. It is suggested that this would be separate from, but related to the society's web site.

5. State Activities

Mark raised the issue of reps in each state organising state activities. Alison reminded the meeting that there was previously a suggestion that state reps be given a budget of \$200.00 for this purpose. This suggestion had not been taken up by any state rep, but according to Arie, the offer still stood.

6. Publisher

Belinda to contact Sage, Federation Press and the University of Queensland Press to obtain quotes for producing the journal.

7. Society

Belinda also to look into the issue of the Society becoming incorporated.
Belinda also to have the society's books officially audited.
Gayre to liaise with Russell Smith to put together a brochure for the Society for inclusion in AIC and other conferences and publications.
